Please dispose of your own rubbish; the local tip is at the top of the hill into Russell, on the Russell side of the crest and to the right; **please do not** use Beryl's rubbish bins at Wairoro next door.

Please leave Yfanwen in the condition as you would wish to find it.


Walking Tracks

Yfanwen has access to excellent walking tracks. For our 20 minute walking track out to Aucks Road, walk down to the boat-shed and follow the path round to the left. The track is well marked and under bush. It intersects with the Okiato to Russell walkway where it emerges at Aucks Road. For the southerly stretch to Okiato and the ferry to Opuia, exit onto the road and look to your right; the entrance is well marked. The northerly stretch to Russell begins in our track about 80 metres before the gate on to Aucks Road and to the left. After crossing to Opuia there is a track along the western side of the Veronica Channel to Paihia. The whole circuit – Yfanwen-Okiato-Opuia-Paihia-Russell-Yfanwen makes a good day of exercise and is mainly under bush.

Dishes and kitchen-ware: Please wash, dry and leave as found.

Television: My Sky Plus with 6 movie and 3 sport channels, in addition to the basic package. Instructions for recording programmes to bypass ads and for later viewing are beside the TV set.

Heat Pump: The control is in a holster above the pump. The yellow button is 'on/off' and the buttons each side control the temperature. We no longer light the wood range in the lounge, however it is fully functional with wood in the garage should you wish to use it.

Access ID is 'Yfanwen WiFi'; password: see welcome book

Rubbish:

Please dispose of your own rubbish either by taking it with you or by disposal at the Russell facility. We do not have a council-provided rubbish collection and black rubbish bags can be purchased at the dairies in Russell for disposal at the local tip. This is at the top of the hill before Russell, on the right. All rubbish is separated there for recycling and no charge is made for recycled items. For un-recycled rubbish bags there is a small charge (\$3 at time of writing).

As stated before, **please do not** use Beryl's rubbish bins at Wairoro next door.

To enable preparation for incoming guests please try to make your departure no later than 10 am. ***Please leave the key on the corner table opposite the front door and leave the door unlocked***
